ISTPCanada and CAIEP/SAFEA (China) are pleased to announce the first Call for Proposals for the Canada-China Science and Technology Partnership Development Activities with the China Association for International Exchange of Personnel (CAIEP).

On April 20, 2009, International Science and Technology Partnerships Canada Inc. (ISTPCanada) and the China Association For International Exchange of Personnel (CAIEP), under the leadership of the State Administration of Foreign Experts Affairs of the Peoples Republic of China (SAFEA), signed a Memorandum of Cooperation for the exchange of Scientific and Technical Personnel, supporting the Partnership Development Activities.

The objectives of these PDAs are to seek innovative ways of cooperation in order to work, collaboratively, on solutions to existing problems and/or innovative improvements to current technologies. These will typically not be participating in recurrent conferences or tradeshows.
