Application Guide for JUACEP Partner Universities Students -- JUACEP Summer 10-Week-Course from June to August 2018 --

Overview

The course sponsors students from University of Michigan, UCLA and University of Toronto, allowing them to conduct research activities at Nagoya University.

Number of students

5-8 graduate students and senior undergraduate students. (Number is subject to change) See <u>Eligibility</u> for more details.

Activities

- Conduct research at Nagoya University research laboratories (2 credits)
- Special lectures for the program
- Plant tour
- Optional Japanese class (1 credit)

Application deadline: March 15, 2018 Notice of acceptance: March 22, 2018 Decision date: March 30, 2018 Due date to find the host professor: April 10, 2018

- 2. Enrollment certificate

*Note: "Registrar" or any equivalent office at your department should sign this.

3. Latest academic transcript

*The transcript should include Fall 2016- Spring 2017 records. Applicants, who have entered to UCLA in 2017 year and do not have Fall 2016- Spring 2017 records, should submit Fall 2017 to present records.

- 4. Student ID copy
- 5. Passport copy (photo page)

*Applicants who do NOT possess a passport at the time of application must send a copy to <u>juacep-office@engg.nagoya-u.ac.jp</u> by E-mail as soon as they obtain it.

6. 6: Headshot photo (JPG format with adequate pixel size for 3cm-width x 4cm-height)
*The face photo only shows the applicant him/herself alone clearly, and he/she must face the front without any head coverings such as caps, sunglasses etc. It has NO background and shadows and is taken within 3 months prior to submission.

Eligibility (All following conditions must be satisfied.)

- (a) Graduate student who will continue study/get degree(s) at UCLA after the program, or Senior undergraduate student who pursue the master's degree program at UCLA after the program.
- (b) GPA must be greater than 3.0/4.0
- (c) Person who can enter and stay in Japan during the whole duration of the program without visa, or who are eligible to get Japan's short-term stay visa.
- (d) Person who for sure re-enters to the country of his/her home university after the completion of the program.
- (e) Person who carries an insurance covering the medical and accident in Japan of the period.

How to find your host professor

You are expected to find your host professor for the independent research by yourself. Go to Labs in Nagoya and check out the researches at Nagoya University. One you found research theme(s) in which you are interested, get in touch with the corresponding professor(s) and ask him/her if he/she accepts you as a JUACEP visiting graduate student. Although you do not have to find the host professor and get his/her approval by the application, we take it into account at the selection of students.

Course credits

Enrolled students can earn the following credits at Nagoya University.

- (a) International Research Project (2 credits for UCLA and U of T, 3 credits for UMich.)
- (b) Optional Japanese class (1 credit)

They will receive a certificate from Nagoya University upon completion of the course.

Scholarship

Selected students may be able to get a scholarship (80,000yen/month) unless they (will) receive the following scholarship(s);

- (a) Japanese Governmental Scholarship
- (b) Scholarship more than 80,000 JPY/month awarded particularly to participate in the program. (In other words, if you receive scholarships that are less than 80,000 JPY/month in total, you will be still considered.)

*JUACEP scholarship is not guaranteed as of January 1, 2018. We expect participating students to be self-supported just in the case that scholarship is not available.

Out of pocket expenses

- (a) Passport
- (b) Visa*
- (c) Round-trip air ticket
- (d) Dormitory fee from June 18 to August 31: 80,000 yen at most, incl. bed linen and internet
- (e) JUACEP participation fee: 10,000 yen
- (f) Campus Personal Liability Insurance: 1,340 yen
- (g) JUACEP research internship tuition: 29,600 yen
- (h) Japanese class tuition: 14,800 yen for those who will take the Japanese class
- (i) Japanese textbook: 3,780 yen for those who will take the Japanese class
- (j) Other living expenses like utilities, meals, local transportation and personal cost will vary by individual.
 - *Visa: The short-term stay visa is required depending on the participant's nationality. It is a single-entry visa.
