Tenure-Track Faculty Position in Mechanical Engineering

The Department of Mechanical Engineering at Memorial University invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position as Assistant Professor in the areas of mechatronics, controls, and/or automation commencing in May 2018 or shortly thereafter. Applicants should hold an undergraduate degree as well as a PhD degree in Mechanical Engineering or in a related discipline. The successful candidate will be expected to register as a professional engineer in Newfoundland and Labrador.

The position (Reference ENGI- 2016-013) is a tenure-track faculty position as Assistant Professor in one or more of the requested areas. Applicants should have a proven ability for excellence in both teaching and research. Duties will include teaching a range of undergraduate and graduate courses in Mechanical Engineering, developing laboratory facilities, supervising graduate and undergraduate student projects, and undertaking an active, funded research program. Rank and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
