# Program Details and Application Guide for JUACEP Partner Universities Students -- JUACEP Summer 10-week-course from June to August 2019 --

#### Overview

The course sponsors students from University of Michigan, UCLA and University of Toronto, allowing them to conduct research activities at Nagoya University.

## **Number of students**

5-8 graduate students and senior undergraduate students from each university. (Number is subject to change.) See **Eligibility** for more details.

#### **Activities**

- Conduct research at Nagoya University research laboratories (2 or 3 credits)
- Special lectures for the program
- Plant tour
- Optional Japanese class (1 credit)

Program period: June 18 - August 30, 2019 (June 17 Check-in and August 31 Check-out)

Application deadline: March 14, 2019 Notice of acceptance: March 25, 2019 Decision date: March 30, 2019

- 2. Enrollment certificate
  - \*Note: "Registrar" or any equivalent office at your department should sign this.
- 3. Latest academic transcript
  - \*The transcript should include Fall 2017- Spring 2018 records. Applicants, who have enrolled in 2018 year and do not have records of Fall 2017- Spring 2018, should submit Fall 2018 to present records.
- 4. Student ID copy
- 5. Passport copy (photo page)
  - \*Applicants who do NOT possess a passport at the time of application must send a copy to <u>juacep-office@engg.nagoya-u.ac.jp</u> by E-mail as soon as obtaining.
- 6. Headshot photo (JPG format with adequate pixel size for 3cm-width x 4cm-height)
  - \*Face photo only shows the applicant him/herself alone clearly, and he/she must face the front without any head coverings such as caps, sunglasses etc. It has no background and shadows and is taken within 3 months prior to submitting.

## **Eligibility (All following conditions must be satisfied.)**

- (a) Graduate student who will continue study/get degree(s) at the home university after the program, or Senior undergraduate student who pursue the master's degree program at the home university after the program.
- (b) GPA must be greater than 3.0/4.0
- (c) Person who can enter and stay in Japan during the whole duration of the program without visa, or who are eligible to get Japan's short-term stay visa.
- (d) Person who for sure re-enters to the country of his/her home university after the completion of the program.
- (e) Person who carries a medical and accident insurance covering through the program period in Japan.

## How to find your host professor

You are expected to find your host professor for the independent research by yourself. Go to <u>Engineering Department</u>, <u>Nagoya University</u>, and check out the researches at Nagoya University. Once you found research theme(s) in which you are interested, get in touch with the corresponding professor(s) and ask him/her if he/she accepts you as a JUACEP visiting scholar (please refer JUACEP). Though you do not have to fix the host professor with his/her approval by the application deadline, we take it into account at the selection of students.

#### **Course credits**

Enrolled students can earn the following credits at Nagoya University.

- (a) International Research Project (2 credits for UCLA and U of T, 3 credits for UM)
- (b) Optional Japanese class for beginner level (1 credit)

Participants will receive a certificate from Nagoya University upon completion of the course.

## **Scholarship**

Selected students may be able to get a scholarship (monthly 80,000 JPY, approximate 730 USD) unless they (will) receive the following scholarship(s);

- (a) Japanese Governmental Scholarship
- (b) Scholarship more than 80,000 JPY/month awarded particularly to participate in JUACEP program from other organization.

## Out of pocket expenses

- (a) Passport
- (b) Visa..... The short-term stay visa is required depending on the participant's nationality. Single-entry visa will be issued. → Japan Immigration Information
- (c) Round-trip air ticket
- (d) Dormitory fee from June 17 to August 31: 80,000 JPY at most, incl. bed linens and Internet
- (e) JUACEP participation fee: 10,000 JPY
- (f) Campus Personal Liability Insurance: 1,340 JPY
- (g) JUACEP research internship tuition: 29,600 JPY/2credits or 44,400 JPY/3credits
- (h) Japanese class tuition: 14,800 JPY for those who will take the Japanese class
- (i) Japanese textbook: 3,780 JPY for those who will take the Japanese class
- (j) Other living expenses like utilities, meals, local transportation and personal cost will vary by individual.
