



MIE Promotion and Progression Regulations

Progression requirements establish the minimum level of achievement necessary for students to advance in their program. There are two categories of progression: Faculty-wide and departmental. Faculty-wide standards determine whether a student is able to proceed to the next session, while departmental standards determine eligibility to move from one year of study to the next.

To proceed to the next year of study (e.g., from second year to third year), the following rules apply:

1. You can have no more than two core (mandatory) courses outstanding from the previous year. If you have more than two outstanding core courses, you will need to complete your remaining requirements in an additional year before advancing.
2. You are not permitted to enroll in courses that are part of the subsequent year's curriculum. For example, a second-year Industrial Engineering student missing MIE250, MIE236 and MIE237 will not be allowed to enrol in a third-year core course or technical elective while completing their second-year requirements. Similarly, for example, a second-year Mechanical Engineering student missing MIE230, MIE270, and MIE210 would not be allowed to take a third year core course or stream until their second-year requirements are fulfilled. This rule applies even when a student has completed the stated prerequisite for a course designed to be taken in the following year.
3. If you have more than two pending grades from the previous year (such as SDF, INC, GWR, etc.), you will not be permitted to proceed to the next year of study. To advance, pending grades must be resolved and replaced with a passing grade on your transcript before the add course deadline. Failure to resolve pending grades by the deadline will result in the inability to progress to the next year of study.
4. Students with a pending grade will be removed from any course for which that course is a prerequisite if the pending grade is not resolved before the add deadline.
