- Attach a 1-page proposal of the project you plan to undertake including: thesis title, objectives, description of activities, evaluation breakdown and a work schedule breakdown. Your proposal must provide an estimate of a level of effort not less than 130 productive hours of work per term.
- Return the form to the MIE Undergraduate Office Department 5 business days prior the last day to add courses.
- If approved, your research thesis will be added to your record on ACORN by the MIE UG Office. If it is not approved, we will notify you and your supervisor by email.
